## Supplementary distribution of income for the media library categories for the 2022 year of use

Dear Member,

in May 2023 the General Assembly resolved that the media library categories (MED and MED VR) were to be established for the distribution of income from the online content provided by broadcasters. In the future, these distributions will be use-based, and we are currently working with the broadcasters to set up a new reporting process to effect this. Until then, we will distribute your income as a supplement.

This supplementary distribution for the 2022 year of use will take place on 1 December 2023. The supplement will be based on your royalties received in the distribution dated 1 July 2023 for uses in 2022 in the TV categories FS and FS VR.

In the media library categories, we will distribute income in respect of providing public access and of broadcasting rights (AR), reproduction rights (VR) and synchronisation rights (HR). The supplements will therefore be differentiated accordingly. Since income for synchronisation rights (HR) is distributed in the TV category FS VR, such supplements will, in relation to media libraries, be counted as supplements to the synchronisation rights in the FS VR category.

The average **supplementary percentages** are:

- 12.3847% in the category FS AR (for MED AR)
- **0.5922%** in the category FS VR (for MED VR)
- **5.9218%** in the category FS AR (for synchronisation rights)

On your account statement, the amounts in the supplementary distribution for media libraries in respect of the 2022 year of use, for the accounting period up to 30 November 2023, are identified by the following accounting texts:

- Supplement for AR MED 2022, professional group (K, T, B, V), special account if applicable, basic category FS
- Supplement for VR MED 2022, professional group (K, T, B, V), special account if applicable, basic category FS VR
- Supplement for HR MED 2022, professional group (K, T, B, V), special account if applicable, basic category FS VR

Please note: the distribution will be based on uses for which distributions have already taken place, so no detailed statements will be issued.
