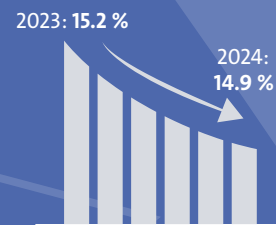
Distribution amount

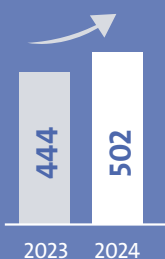

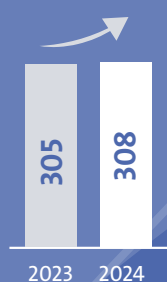

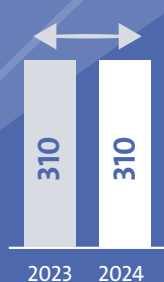
Public musical performance

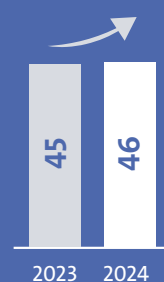

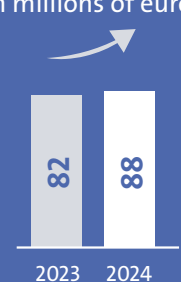
