Tariff for the playback of GEMA repertoire works for entertainment purposes, but without event character, during trade fairs and exhibitions

I. GENERAL LICENCE FEE RATES

1. by means of sound recordings		
per stand	17,70€	per day
2. by means of radio broadcasts		
per stand	11,90€	per day
3. by means of TV broadcasts		
3.1. per TV set 3.2. large screen* or TV/video wall	6,10€	per day
per 100 sq.m. (or parts thereof) of exhibition space	11,90€	per day
4. by means of audiovisual (AV) recordings		
4.1. per playback device (= monitor)4.2. large-screen projection* or video wall	29,70€	per day
per 100 sq.m. (or parts thereof) of exhibition space	59,30€	per day

* Large screens in terms of the licence fee rates shall be monitors with a diagonal of more than 42 inches.

II. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Area of application

These licence fee rates shall apply for the playback of GEMA repertoire works for entertainment purposes, but without event character

- a) [for] playback by means of sound recordings and AV recordings
- b) [for the] communication to the public of radio and TV broadcasts

exclusively at trade fairs and exhibitions, as long as the stands exhibit a surface area of up to 1,000 sq.m., and the exploitation is carried out in the exhibitors' own name and at his own expense.

2. Timely acquisition of a licence

The licence fee rates shall only apply if the respective licence has been acquired from GEMA in a timely manner prior to the respective use.

3. Scope of the licence

The licence shall only cover the rights GEMA is entitled to.

The licence fee rates shall be payable irrespective of the amount of GEMA repertoire works communicated to the public or the extent of which the granted right of use is actually exhausted.

4. General agreement discounts

Members of organisations with whom GEMA has concluded a general agreement for this tariff shall be granted a discount in line with the contractual provisions of said general agreement.
