Data Protection Declaration

GEMA currently conducts an Electronic Confirmation Process with the intention to clarify the contractual relationships between authors and publishers pursuant to the judgement by the Higher Regional Court dated 14/11/2016 (Az. 24 U 96/14). In order to be able to gather the necessary declarations from the authors, the publisher needs to contact the authors with whom it entertains contractual relationships. Since the publisher does not possess the necessary contact details, it has asked GEMA to provide the missing contact data relating to the publishers' authors. The data to be provided by GEMA includes - as far as the data is registered with GEMA - address, phone number and e-mail address of the authors. The data transfer is subject to Art. 28 para. 2 item 2 a) BDSG [German Data Protection Act].

The publisher commits to use the transferred data solely in order to contact its authors with whom it entertains contractual relations, for the purpose of carrying out the Electronic Confirmation Process. The publisher shall not pass on the data it has received from GEMA to any third parties. The publisher is obliged to abide by the requirements for the protection of personal data, in particular the provisions of the Bundesdatenschutzgesetz [German Federal Data Protection Act] (BDSG), including the requirements as listed in the appendix to said law.
